

Line Technician Scholarship \$1,000

Line technicians are responsible for the success of our electrical systems. Line technicians have challenging yet rewarding careers that allow them to serve their communities, receive a good wage and provides many opportunities for advancement. They perform many different tasks in a variety of situations including installing, maintaining, and repairing electrical distribution lines, climbing and installing poles, and inspecting overhead and underground power lines.

Shelby Energy Cooperative is offering a \$1,000 scholarship for high school seniors who will attend an approved line technician training program in pursuit of the education and skills necessary to begin a career as a line technician.

Eligibility:

- Applicant must be a graduating high school senior planning to enroll in an approved line technician training program as a full time student.
- Applicant must have a parent or guardian that is a member in good standing with Shelby Energy Cooperative
- Scholarship recipients will be announced at their high school awards program and Shelby Energy Cooperative's Annual Meeting in June. Recipients should plan to attend and be recognized at this event.
- Recipients will be selected by a panel of judges not employed by Shelby Energy Cooperative based on the following criteria:
 - **School/ Community Involvement**
 - **Academic and Personal Achievements**
 - ♦Essay
 - ♦GPA
 - **♦SAT/ACT Scores**
 - *<u>¢Legitimate Financial Need</u>*

- An official copy of the applicant's transcript and ACT/SAT scores
- Resume or written list of all extracurricular activities and community involvement
- Most Recent School Photo (head and shoulders pose only)
- Paragraph (separate from essay) describing financial need
- Letter of Recommendation from a high school teacher, coach or guidance counselor.
- An essay of at least 500 words explaining why you are interested in a career in the electrical utilities industry. (Entries are judged on content, grammar and spelling)

Judging Criteria: School Involvement (10%) Community and Personal Achievements (10%) Essay (25%)
Grade Point Average & ACT/SAT Score (25%) Legitimate Financial Need (30%)

Limitations of Scholarships:

- Must use the scholarship within one (1) year of receiving the award
- Excludes immediate family of employees or directors of Shelby Energy Cooperative
- This Scholarship is not renewable
- Scholarship funds are paid directly to the school for tuition and books only
